The Triple Antibody *Test, Manage & Monitor Programme* (TMMP) offers employers and managers the means to search out, monitor and manage the asymptomatic presence of C19 within a population e.g. in work, school, higher education, thereby introducing additional safeguards to help keep the workplace as safe as possible during fluctuating levels of C19 infection in the community.

Challenges businesses and organisations are facing today

- PCR (swab) testing is not available en masse to businesses or organisations to use privately for their 'populations'
- 1-3 day turn around per test
- 30% false negative

The solution: Triple Antibody *Test, Monitor & Manage Programme*

Businesses and organisations can test their population, and, through our secure digital platform, monitor and manage the C19 status of their population.

- Triple antibody testing to detect current and historic infection
- Testing fully managed by trained first aiders or clinicians
- Tests administered on site (or an agreed, safe location)
- Results in 20 minutes
- Clinical advice and guidance in line with PHE recommendations for self-isolation of possible positive cases
- Results securely and digitally stored on the platform with real-time dashboarding plus, the individual has their own C19 status available in their digital wallet app





How the *Test, Monitor & Manage Programme* works:

- 1) Triple antibody tests are supplied to the business or organisation
- 2) We train on site first aiders or clinicians both how to do the tests and analyse the results and supply ongoing support when needed.
- 3) We take the test results, upload into business or organisation's secure section of the platform and the individual's digital wallet app, plus provide ongoing support for businesses and organisationswith real-time, tailored dashboarding of results.

Overview and Key Benefits

- Near patient tests for C19 are used to monitor the health of the population over time.
- The test results are used to identify possible cases of C19 in asymptomatic individuals and isolate them, reducing the risk of transmission of the virus to other members of the group.
- The TMMP fully aligns with the UK Government/Public Health England approach to diagnostic testing using RNA-PCR swab tests for symptomatic individuals and goes one step further by providing an additional level of assessment and risk management for individuals who have no symptoms.
- The TMMP testing strategy introduces a greater level of safety by isolating an individual who is found to have a positive test i.e. possible C19 infection.
- The TMMP may result in a low rate of over-isolation of individuals who are in fact negative for C19 (we estimate this to be around 2% of those tested, based on existing data).

- The TMMP does not replace the need for ongoing C19 precautionary measures such as social distancing, hand hygiene, PPE, and the implementation of Covid-secure arrangements in the workplace.
- The TMMP comprises regular and frequent testing because;
 - the risk of acquisition of C19 is ever-present, and is likely to increase during the winter months
 - rates of C19 in different parts of the community fluctuate
 - individuals may test negative in the first days of a new infection
- Improved operational effectiveness and employee welfare has been observed in a work place setting where the TMMP has already been introduced.
